

# Rabbit Resistant Plants

\*these plants are *Resistant*; rabbits may still indulge under certain conditions



<b>ACHILLEA (YARROW)</b>	Xeriscape. Full sun. Height and color varies with species.
<b>AGASTACHE (HYSSOP)</b>	Generally xeric, full sun plants. Take the heat well. Aromatic foliage and various color mint-like flower spikes in mid to late summer. Attractive to wildlife.
<b>ALLIUM (ORNAMENTAL ONION)</b>	Bulb plant with rounded clusters of star-shaped flowers of various colors depending on variety. Green strap-like foliage. Full sun. Can have an onion or garlic scent.
<b>ANTHEMIS (GOLDEN MARGUERITE)</b>	Orange-yellow colored daisies on feathery foliage. Grows to 3 feet tall. Full Sun.
<b>AQUILEGIA (COLUMBINE)</b>	Shade loving, open plant with blue green foliage and variable flower color. Blooms during cooler temperatures. Can make a nice cut flower. Needs good drainage. Height varies from 6" to 18" with variety.
<b>ARTEMISIA (SAGE)</b>	Aromatic, foliage plants with gray or gray-green leaves that vary with variety. Xeric, full sun. Some varieties can be invasive.
<b>ARCOSTAPHYLOS (KINICKINICK)</b>	Shiny, dark evergreen leaves cover low lying branches. Spring flowers are pink, followed by bright red fruits. Winter color is a dark maroon red. Xeric. Grows 3-6" tall, 2-6' wide. Hardy to 10,000'. Part shade to shade.
<b>CALYLOPHUS (SUNDROPS)</b>	Butter yellow flowers on an attractive spreading groundcover. Grows to 6". Full sun.
<b>CARYOPTERIS (BLUE MIST SPIREA)</b>	Fragrant, silvery-green foliage and upright branches. Soft, lavender-blue flowers bloom July-August and attract bees. Prune to the ground in Spring. Grows 3-4' tall & wide. Full sun. Zone 5
<b>DIGITALIS (FOXGLOVE)</b>	Beautiful, upright plant with felty, green leaves & pink, red or yellowish flowers. Some varieties are biennial. Needs part shade to perform best. Poisonous.
<b>ECHINACEA (CONEFLOWER)</b>	Popular 24"-48", pink or white daisy with dark brown cone center. Large dark green leathery leaves. Attracts wildlife. Excellent in full sun, dry locations. Blooms July-August.
<b>ECHINOPS (GLOBE THISTLE)</b>	Round, blue flower heads on coarse, thistle foliage. Full sun. Excellent cut or dried flower. Great in border for intense blue color.
<b>ERIOGONUM (SULPHUR FLOWER)</b>	Dark green foliage, white underneath in matting rosettes. Thin stalks form umbrella-like clusters with smaller floral buttons of tiny sulphur-yellow flowers. Blooms early to mid-summer. Grows 6-12" tall, 8-12" wide
<b>GAILLARDIA (BLANKET FLOWER)</b>	Excellent sun-loving, xeric, carefree perennial. Blooms virtually all summer with yellow and burgundy flowers. Great cut flower. Compact varieties available.
<b>GAURA (WHIRLING BUTTERFLIES)</b>	Tall, 36"- 48", open plant with small leaves and butterfly-shaped white to pink flowers all summer long. Beautiful in the breeze. Full sun.
<b>GAZANIA</b>	Small, compact rosette with leathery dark green leaves and bright yellow daisy-like flowers most of the season. Full sun. Good in rock gardens or the front of the border.
<b>HELIANTHUS (SUNFLOWER)</b>	Variable height, coarse plants with large yellow flowers for a dry, full sun area. May reseed.

<b>HYMENOXYIS (OLD MAN OF THE MOUNTAIN)</b>	Native of the mountains. Slow growing, rock garden plant with large yellow daisy-like flowers in midsummer. Very long lived.
<b>KNIPHOFIA (TORCH LILY)</b>	Poker-shaped flowers in vibrant orange to red to yellow colors with thick, grass-like foliage. Excellent specimen plant . Prefers full sun and dry soil. Grows 24"- 36".
<b>LAVANDULA (LAVENDER)</b>	Excellent perennial herb that needs full sun and dry conditions. Grey-green, needle-like leaves with dark blue to lavender flower spikes in the summer. Very fragrant. Good for drying. Grows 12"- 18".
<b>LINUM (FLAX)</b>	Large, bright blue, single flowers on fine textured foliage. Full sun and drought tolerant. Will bloom all summer if plants are cut back frequently. Grows 24". Will reseed.
<b>NEPETA (CATMINT)</b>	Spreading, upright stems of small, felty gray-green leaves with lavender flowers. Will bloom all summer if cut back. Grows 24"- 36". Full sun, fairly drought tolerant once established. Fast growing.
<b>PENSTEMON</b>	Large variety of mostly upright, sun loving plants with brilliant, tubular flowers in a variety of colors. Most bloom in early summer. Height, form, and foliage color vary with species and variety. Prefer full sun and well drained to dry soil.
<b>PEROVSKIA (RUSSIAN SAGE)</b>	Large, herbaceous shrub with finely cut aromatic foliage. Purple flower spikes appear in late summer. Grows 36"- 48". Full sun, drought tolerant once established.
<b>SALVIA</b>	Dense, mounding perennials with long, thin spikes of blue, pink or white flowers in summer. Often will re-bloom if deadheaded. Aromatic, dark green to grayish foliage. Attractive to wildlife. Full sun, drought tolerant. 18"- 24".
<b>SANTOLINA (LAVENDER COTTON)</b>	Full sun, dry land herb with very small leaves, either green or gray. Gold, button-like blooms in summer. Good edging plant. Very fragrant when crushed.
<b>SCROPHULARIA (FIGWORT)</b>	AKA Red Birds in a tree. Brilliant red flowers in late spring. Grows 3 feet tall. Sun to part shade, and prefers moist soil.
<b>SCUTELLARIA (SKULLCAP)</b>	Small mounding plant grows to 6" tall. Comes in a variety of colors, from pink, to blue, to white.
<b>SEDUM (STONECROP)</b>	Very large group of xeric, sun loving, succulent plants. Size, form, leaf and flower color will vary with species. Good for rock gardens, between pavers, groundcovers or borders.
<b>SILENE (ALPINE CATCHFLY)</b>	Very low growing, rock garden plant with small medium green leaves. Hot pink flowers on strong stem in late summer to early fall. Full sun.
<b>STACHYS (LAMB'S EARS)</b>	Low growing, spreading foliage plant with gray, felty leaves. Some varieties have purple flower spikes in midsummer. Prefers full sun and dry soil.
<b>TEUCRIUM (GERMANDER)</b>	Golden green leaves w/ a central green splash and short, frothy spikes of mauve flowers. Needs moist well-drained soil. Grows 12-24" tall. Sun to part shade. Zone 5
<b>THYMUS (THYME)</b>	Many varieties of fast growing ground cover. All with very small, fragrant leaves and small, often pink to lavender colored flowers. Most varieties need full sun and drier conditions. Great for rock gardens and between pavers.
<b>ZINNIA</b>	Produces bright, deep yellow flowers from late summer on. This plant will not grow or break dormancy until the heat of early summer arrives. Deer & rabbit resistant. Prefers full sun, in a hot, dry location. Grows 4" tall, 15" wide. Zone 4
<b>ZIZOPHORA</b>	Grows 15" x 15" wide. Intensely mint scented perennial with clouds of blue, thyme-like flowers in the summer. It is highly attractive to butterflies and re-seeds nicely. Zones 5-9.
