ABOUT SANSEVIERIA

Sansevieria, most commonly referred to as Snake Plants or Mother-In-Law's Tongue, are beloved for their spectacular appearance and their easy-care nature. They are known for their tolerance to low-light conditions, are happiest when slightly root-bound, are great air-purifying plants, and come in many shapes, sizes, colors, and patterns.

WATER



Allow soil to dry out between waterings.

LIGHT



Medium to bright indirect light. Can tolerate low light.

SOIL

Well draining potting mix

PET SAFE?



Mildly toxic

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize once in spring and once in summer using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). Be careful not to overfertilize!

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Snake Plants are actually a drought-tolerant succulent. They grow best in containers where they are slightly root-bound. If kept in a low-light space, watering once per month may be sufficient. Be careful not to overwater.

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
