ABOUT DRACAENA

There are many different types of Dracaena that go by many names, some of which include “Dragon Plant” and “Corn Plant”. They are renowned for their tree-like growth habit and their unique foliage, which is characterized by spiky leaves that come in various colors including many different shades of green, reddish-brown, purple, and even pale pink.

WATER



Allow soil to dry out between waterings. Slightly drought tolerant.

LIGHT



Bright indirect light. Tolerant of low light.

SOIL

Well draining potting mix

PET SAFE?



Mildly toxic

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize 1-2 times per month during the growing season using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). **Always follow package instructions.**

HUMIDITY

High
(60%-80%)



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Use distilled water or allow water to sit out over night to avoid the tips of the leaves turning brown and crispy.

Dracaena are slightly drought tolerant and are especially susceptible to root rot, so be careful not to overwater.

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
