ABOUT HOSTA

Hostas are a great choice for shaded areas. With their lush foliage and low-maintenance qualities, they bring charm to any garden from spring to fall. Hostas are easy to care for and require minimal upkeep. When planting, make sure to consider the mature size of the variety and provide adequate spacing between each plant.

Grows best in acidic, loamy, well-draining soil.

FERTILIZATION

Add a layer of compost or slow release fertilizer in the spring.

HELPFUL TIP

To prevent powdery mildew in Hostas, use a drip hose to water the base of the plants, ensuring the leaves remain dry, as moisture on the leaves can create a breeding ground for the fungus.

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
