ABOUT FERNS

Caring for ferns involves creating an environment that mimics their natural habitat. Provide indirect light, consistent moisture, well-draining soil, and adequate humidity. Regular misting, grouping plants, or using a humidifier is highly recommended. Protecting ferns from drafts and temperature extremes will also help to maintain their health and vitality.

WATER



Maintain moist soil. Do not allow soil to become waterlogged.

Medium to bright indirect light

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize once per month using a well-balanced fertilizer in spring and summer. Fertilize every other month in fall and winter.
