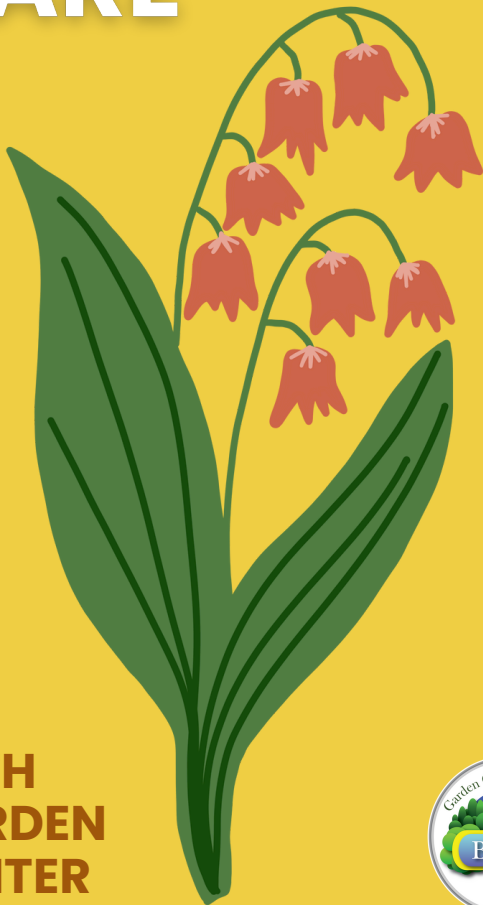

ABOUT HEUCHERA

Heuchera, also known as Coral Bells, is a captivating addition to any garden. These charming plants have bell-shaped flowers that bloom from spring until fall. They are set apart by their bold and colorful foliage, which comes in a wide array of hues. Many varieties exhibit their most vibrant leaf colors when grown in full sun, though they can tolerate shaded areas.

Feed in the spring with
compost or a light
amount of slow-release
fertilizer.

HELPFUL TIP

Prevent frost heaving by mulching around the plants with weed-free organic materials like composted manure, wood chips, or bark chips in the fall to insulate the soil.
