WATER



Allow top 2 inches of soil to dry out between waterings

LIGHT



Partial shade, 2-5 hours of filtered sunlight

BLOOM TIME

Summer – Fall

MATURE SIZE

6-8 in. tall,
6-12 in. wide

FERTILIZATION

Use a phosphorous-rich fertilizer when actively growing to promote blooming.

Always follow package instructions.

SOIL

Prefers moist but well-draining soil

CARE TIPS:

Begonias grow well in pots, both indoors and outdoors. For outdoor settings, a terra cotta pot with good drainage is recommended for optimal growth.

If you're looking for a begonia variety that can tolerate direct sunlight, wax leaf begonias are an excellent choice.



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
