Orchids, belonging to the Orchidaceae family, are primarily epiphytic plants that grow on trees and rocks in their native habitats rather than in the ground. WATER



Water once per week.
Do not let roots sit in
standing water.

LIGHT



Medium to bright
indirect light

SOIL

Sphagnum moss
or bark medium

PET SAFE?



Safe

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize weakly, weekly
with an orchid-specific
fertilizer.

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Do not use ice cubes to water.
Cold temperatures can shock
the plant and damage the
roots.

Use a fertilizer specifically
formulated for orchid blooms
to stimulate blooming.

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
