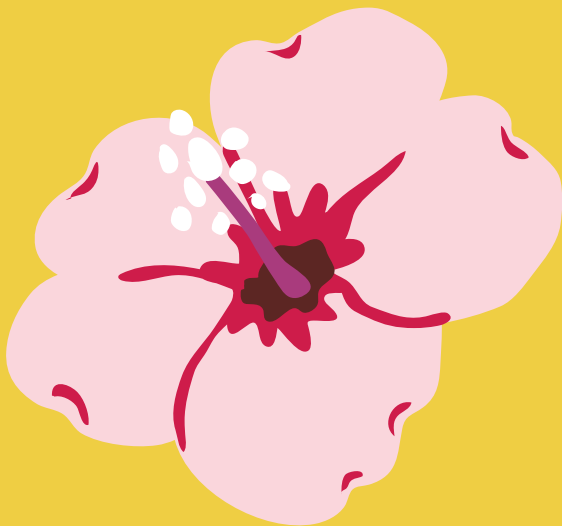

ABOUT HARDY HIBISCUS

Hardy Hibiscus is a stunning addition to gardens with its big, showy flowers in shades of pink, purple, red, and white. They can be planted in spring after the risk of frost passes. Hardy Hibiscus quickly grows into impressive blooms, sometimes as big as dinner plates.

WATER



2-3x per week

LIGHT



Full sun

BLOOM TIME

Summer - Fall

MATURE SIZE

3-7 ft. tall, 2-5 ft. wide

SOIL

Fertile, well-draining

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize weekly with diluted liquid fertilizer or use slow-release fertilizer once during the spring, summer, and fall.
