ABOUT ZZ PLANTS

The ZZ Plant (*Zamioculcas zamiifolia*) has gained popularity in recent years for its ability to thrive in a wide range of conditions. It can tolerate low light and has low water requirements, making it an easy, low-maintenance option for indoor spaces. It also features extremely unique, eye-catching foliage.

WATER



Allow soil to dry out between waterings.

LIGHT



Medium to bright indirect light. Can tolerate low light.

SOIL

Well draining potting mix

PET SAFE?



Highly toxic

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize once in spring and once in summer using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). Be careful not to overfertilize!

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Large potato-like rhizomes can often be found under the surface of the ZZ Plant's soil intertwined with their roots. They serve as water storage organs to aid the plant in surviving drought conditions in its native habitat. Thrives when slightly root-bound.
