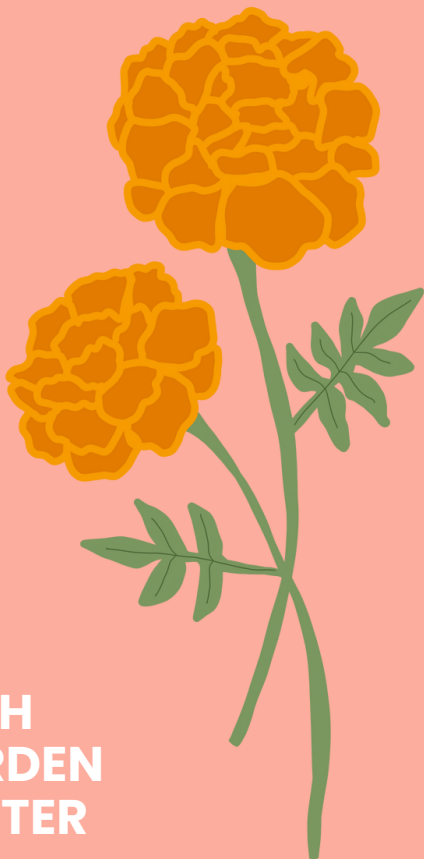

ABOUT MARIGOLDS

Marigolds are among the most common and reliable bedding flowers. As true annuals, they complete their life cycles in a single growing season, though they easily reseed themselves, coming back year after year. Marigolds are not only beautiful but also low-maintenance, requiring minimal care to thrive and bloom abundantly.

WATER



Water when the top inch of soil is dry

LIGHT



Full sun, 6+ hours per day

BLOOM TIME

Summer – Fall

MATURE SIZE

4-48 in. tall,
6-24 in. wide

FERTILIZATION

Marigolds do not require fertilizer. Feed only if the soil is extremely poor in nutrients.

SOIL

Tolerant of many soil types. Prefers fertile, well-draining soils.

FUN FACT:

Marigolds emit a fragrance that repels many common garden pests, making them a fantastic companion plant. Plant in your vegetable or flower gardens to repel tomato worms, thrips, whiteflies, and more.
