ABOUT BLEEDING HEARTS

The Bleeding Heart is known for its unique heart-shaped blossoms. Bleeding Hearts range in size from 1 to 3 feet tall. It exhibits a moderate growth rate, reaching its maximum size in approximately 60 days. However, it's essential to be mindful of where you plant it, as the Bleeding Heart is toxic to both people and pets if ingested.

WATER



2-3x per week

LIGHT



Shade - partial sun

BLOOM TIME

Spring - Summer

MATURE SIZE

1-3 ft. tall, 2-3 ft. wide

SOIL

Humus-rich, moist, well-draining soil high in organic matter

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize in early spring with a high phosphorus fertilizer (20-30-20).

Butterflies and hummingbirds are the primary pollinators of Bleeding Hearts. It also receives assistance in seed dispersal from ants! Bleeding Hearts grow best in light shade.

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
