ABOUT POTHOS

Pothos are beginner-friendly houseplants known for how easy they are to care for. Native to islands in the South Pacific, these vining plants can be trained to climb or trail from a pot or hanging basket. It is highly adaptable and able to grow in many different environments, making it a highly popular houseplant.

WATER



Allow soil to dry out between waterings.

LIGHT



Medium to bright indirect light. Can tolerate low light.

SOIL

Well draining potting mix

PET SAFE?



Highly toxic

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize 1-2 times per month during the growing season using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). **Always follow package instructions.**

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Pothos are easy to propagate. Simply take a 2-3 leaf cutting with several viable nodes. Place in water and allow roots to form.

This plant is low-maintenance, can tolerate low light, and is ideal for beginners.

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
