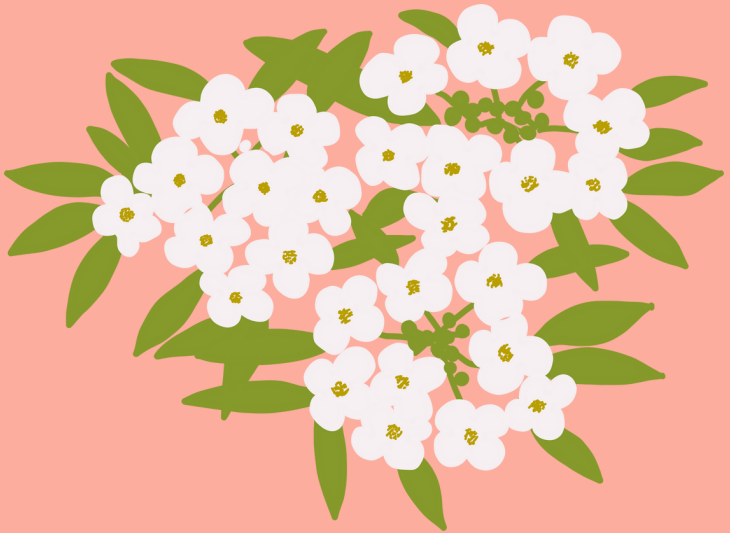

ABOUT ALYSSUM

Sweet alyssum is a delightful choice for filling in gaps in both containers and flower beds. Its low-growing foliage quickly forms a carpet of tiny, cross-shaped flowers. Not only does it provide vibrant blooms, but it's also cold-weather tolerant, making it an excellent option for spring and fall.

WATER



Allow top 2 inches of soil to dry out between waterings

LIGHT



Full sun to part shade, 6+ hours per day

BLOOM TIME

Spring - Fall

MATURE SIZE

3-10 in. tall,
2-4 in. wide

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize containerized plants once every 2-3 weeks with a well balance fertilizer.

Always follow package instructions.

SOIL

Requires moist but well-draining soil

CARE TIPS:

Alyssum is susceptible to diseases such as downy mildew, stem and crown rot, and general decline when planted in soil with poor drainage. Ensure soil is well-draining to help avoid issues with overwatering. Watering at the base keeps water off the leaves and also helps prevent these issues.



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
