ABOUT DAHLIA

Dahlias are late-season flowers that bloom from midsummer through the first frost, offering a vast variety of colors, patterns, sizes, and flower forms. They can range from small border plants to giant plate-sized blooms atop 6-foot plants, adding vibrant splashes of color and intricate beauty to any garden.

WATER



Do not allow soil to dry out completely in between waterings.

LIGHT



Full sun, 6+ hours per day

BLOOM TIME

Summer – Fall

MATURE SIZE

15–72 in. tall,
12–36 in. wide

FERTILIZATION

Use a fertilizer low in nitrogen every 2–3 weeks for containerized dahlias.

Always follow package instructions.

SOIL

Requires loose, well-draining soil. Does not tolerate heavy soils.



CARE TIPS:

Proper pruning is essential for optimal growth. When the plant reaches approximately 16 inches in height, prune by pinching the top tips above a set of healthy leaves. This technique encourages the growth of multiple new stems, replacing the pinched central stem.
