ABOUT AFRICAN DAISIES

African daisies are versatile plants that work equally well in the ground or in containers. They belong to the Asteraceae family, along with Shasta daisies and zinnias. These relatively low-maintenance flowers are loved for their vivid coloring, which sets them apart from the classic daisy.

WATER



Keep soil evenly moist, but never soggy

LIGHT



Full sun, 6+ hours per day

BLOOM TIME

Summer - Fall

MATURE SIZE

1-3 ft. tall,
1-2 ft. wide

FERTILIZATION

Feed every 1-2 weeks with a phosphorous-rich fertilizer to encourage blooming.

Always follow package instructions.

SOIL

Requires moist, well-draining soils

CARE TIPS:

During periods of drought or intense heat, the growth of these plants will slow and they may go dormant. During these periods, aim to keep the soil evenly moist to help keep your African daisies happy and healthy.



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
