ABOUT SPIDER PLANTS

The Spider Plant (*Chlorophytum comosum*) is a highly favored houseplant due to its easy care requirements and rapid growth of baby plants, resembling spiders. Its trailing growth makes it ideal for hanging baskets and it is a great air purifying houseplant. Spider Plants are drought tolerant and also tolerant of low light conditions.

WATER



Allow soil to dry out between waterings.

LIGHT



Bright indirect light.
Can tolerate low light conditions.

SOIL

Well draining
potting mix

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize once per month during the growing season using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). **Always follow package instructions.**

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



FUN FACTS:

Spider plants will self-propagate by producing plantlets when they are in ideal growing conditions.

Spider plants store water in their roots, making them very drought tolerant. Be careful not to overwater!

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
