ABOUT BIRD OF PARADISE

Bird of Paradise is a tropical evergreen native to South Africa. A close relation to the banana tree, these plants are often mistaken for each other. While flowering indoors is rare, it may happen under ideal conditions, including full southern light exposure, proper humidity and temperature, and adequate fertilizing.

WATER



Water every 1-2 weeks.
Allow soil to dry out
between waterings.

LIGHT



Direct sunlight.
Can tolerate bright
indirect light.

SOIL

Well draining
potting mix

PET SAFE?



Highly toxic

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize 1-2 times per month
during the growing season
using a balanced fertilizer
(10-10-10). **Always follow
package instructions.**

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)



FUN FACT:

Birds of Paradise have evolved
to create splits along their
lateral leaf seams, reducing
the risk of being snapped by
strong winds.

It is best to water with filtered
water. Alternate option: Let tap
water sit overnight before use.

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
