ABOUT AFRICAN VIOLETS

African Violets are beloved houseplants renowned for their frequent flowering and diverse leaf colors. They feature compact, low-growing habits with thick, fuzzy leaves forming a distinctive rosette. Their flowers bloom above the evergreen foliage, making them a popular choice for indoor gardening.

WATER



Keep soil evenly moist.
Bottom watering is highly recommended.

LIGHT



Bright indirect or direct morning light

SOIL

African Violet specific potting mix

PET SAFE?



Safe

FERTILIZATION

Requires fertilizer specific to African Violets. Fertilize with every watering according to package instructions.

HUMIDITY

Moderate
(40%-60%)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

To encourage blooming, ensure regular fertilization. They typically bloom best when slightly rootbound.

Avoid getting water on the leaves and plant in a pot specific to African Violets for best growing results.



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
