FERTILIZATION

Fertilize 1-2 times per month during the growing season using a balanced fertilizer (10-10-10). **Always follow package instructions.**

FUN FACT:

Alocasias grow from tubers or rhizomes, and while their foliage is toxic, certain varieties are often farmed in more tropical environments for the edible bulb that grows beneath the soil (taro root).

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
